Sunday 22 June

- Moderator | Pray for the Moderator of the General Assembly, the Rt Rev Dr Trevor Gribben, as he attends the National Prayer Breakfast in Westminster on Tuesday 24 June. Pray for all those serving in the UK Parliament, both in the House of Commons and the House of Lords.
